Spun-lace nonwoven and/or woven fabric containing 100% meta-aramid or blends with para-aramid, PBI and/or viscose FR (fibres accepted by OEKO-TEX® having flame retardant properties) laminated to a waterproof breathable membrane made of polyether polyurethane and e-PTFE. The fabric is bonded to the film by a hotmelt polyurethane adhesive. The fabric has or does not have a water repellent and/or antimicrobial treatment with products accepted by OEKO-TEX® having biological active properties and is coated.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class III** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for products without direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
